ELEC's 20-day postelection report figures show that the 1989 election for the State Assembly was the most expensive in New Jersey history.

Frederick M. Herrmann, Executive Director of the Election Law Enforcement Commission, announced today that total receipts reported by Assembly candidates through November 27, 1989 amounted to \$9,787,549 and expenditures to \$7,653,744.

According to Herrmann, these figures indicate that since 1985, when the Gubernatorial and Assembly races last occurred together, receipts have increased by 49 percent and spending by 42 percent. At the same time in 1985 receipts totaled \$6,581,409 and expenditures \$5,395,961.

When the Assembly and Senate ran together two years ago, in 1987, Assembly candidates reported raising \$7,705,908 and spending \$5,549,476 on their 20-day postelection filing. Therefore, receipts increased by 17 percent between 1985 and 1987 and expenditures by 3 percent. Between 1987 and 1989, Assembly fundraising increased by 27 percent and expenditures by 38 percent.

"As predicted in earlier releases, these statistics confirm that the 1989 Assembly election was easily the most expensive race in State history," said Herrmann. "This fundraising arms race dramatically illustrates that campaign finance reform is desperately needed in New Jersey."

"ELEC is very concerned," continued Herrmann, "that this dramatic pace of fundraising without contribution limits, PAC registration, and employer disclosure by contributors of over \$100 may lead to further voter disenchantment with the electoral process and distrust of government in general."

Along party lines the 20-day postelection report figures show Democratic candidates reporting receipts of \$5,669,352 and expenditures of \$4,540,722. Republicans raised \$4,114,423 and spent \$3,109,252.

The preliminary statistics indicate that Democratic candidates raised 38 percent more and spent 46 percent more money than their Republican counterparts. In 1985, Republicans outraised Democrats by 26 percent, \$3,655,569 to \$2,889,838, and outspent them by 12 percent, \$2,842,121 to \$2,528,531. During 1987, Republicans raised 5 percent more than Democrats, \$3,935,682 to \$3,747,962, and spent 6 percent more, \$2,854,254 to \$2,690,382.

Between 1985 and the present, Democratic Assembly candidates increased their receipts by 96 percent, \$2,889,838 to \$5,669,352, whereas Republican candidates increased theirs by 13 percent, \$3,655,569 to \$4,114,423. Democratic spending rose during this four-year period by 80 percent, \$2,528,531 to \$4,540,722, and Republican expenditures by 9 percent, \$2,842,121 to \$3,109,252.

Herrmann noted that between 1985 and 1987 Democratic receipts increased by 30 percent, \$2,889,838 to \$3,747,962 and their expenditures by 6 percent, \$2,528,531 to \$2,690,382. Herrmann said that Republicans increased their fundraising during this period by 8 percent, \$3,655,569 to \$3,935,682, while their spending remained stable, \$2,842,121 to \$2,854,254.

Herrmann added that from 1987 to 1989, Assembly Democrats' fundraising increased by 51 percent, \$3,747,962 to \$5,669,352, while their expenditures rose by 69 percent, \$2,690,382 to \$4,540,722. Republican receipts increased by 5 percent, \$3,935,682 to \$4,114,423. Their expenditures increased by 9 percent, from \$2,854,254 to \$3,109,252.

According to the figures, incumbents again dominated the financial activity of all Assembly candidates.

The 20-day postelection reports show incumbents raising 65 percent of the funds collected, \$6,323,790, and spending 63 percent of the total expenditures, \$4,829,431. Assembly challengers raised only \$3,463,759 and spent \$2,824,313.

"As in previous years," said Herrmann, "incumbents thoroughly dominated the race for dollars. Consequently, their ability to communicate their message to the electorate was much greater than that of their challengers. Such an imbalance is not a healthy sign for democracy in this State. ELEC believes publicly-financed legislative races will help the challengers to compete on a more level playing field."

In 1985, Assembly incumbents raised 64 percent of the funds and spent 62 percent of them while in 1987 they raised 55 percent of the campaign money and spent 52 percent of it.

From 1985 to 1989, Assembly incumbents increased their receipts by 51 percent, from \$4,184,289 to \$6,323,790. Expenditures by incumbents during this period also increased, rising by 45 percent, \$3,330,619 to \$4,829,431. Over the four-year span, challengers increased their fundraising by 44 percent, \$2,397,121 to \$3,463,759, and their spending by 37 percent, \$2,065,342 to \$2,824,313.

During the two-year period 1985-1987, incumbent receipts rose by one percent, \$4,184,289 to \$4,215,795. Incumbent expenditures declined by 13 percent, \$3,330,619 to \$2,912,484.

Challengers increased their receipts by 46 percent, \$2,397,121 to \$3,490,113, and their expenditures by 28 percent, \$2,065,342 to \$2,636,992.

Between 1987 and 1989, incumbents further increased their receipts by 50 percent, \$4,215,795 to \$6,323,790, and their expenditures by 66 percent, from \$2,912,484 to \$4,829,431. Challenger receipts decreased by 1 percent, \$3,490,113

to \$3,463,759, but their spending increased by 8 percent, \$2,636,992 to \$2,824,313.

Herrmann noted that winners outraised and outspent losers by a wide margin. Winners raised 138 percent more than losers in 1989, \$6,888,443 to \$2,899,107. They spent 116 percent more, \$5,230,563 to \$2,423,181.

Herrmann concluded, "campaign reform is absolutely vital if financial activity is to be adequately controlled and a more level playing field between incumbents and challengers is to be created. What is at stake is the perpetuation of the democratic process in New Jersey."

This press release is a compilation of figures reported on the 20-day postelection reports of candidates and committees. Only those reports received as of 5:00 p.m. on November 28, 1989 were included; those reports received after that date were not considered

Figures are based upon data taken directly from each report, prior to any thorough mathematical or technical review. Therefore, the figures may change at a later date after the review process is completed.

Also, please be reminded that candidates and committees may transfer funds between each other. Although these transfers are counted in ELEC's statistics as receipts and expenditures, they are not transactions which create new funds. Nevertheless, ELEC's figures create a useful indicator of overall fundraising and spending in the General 1989 election.
