Dear Mr. Verney:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 19, 1974. While it is possible for us to grant the extension to Association Management Corporation by virtue of having their name in our records from your letter of March 19, 1974, it is not possible to offer any protection for the remaining 28 trade associations without having their names. Such "protection" would be protection in addition to that afforded each of them by virtue of being a party to the class action suit brought by the New Jersey State Chamber of Commerce. There is an Injunctive Order which has been entered in that suit which prevents the Commission from imposing the filing deadline set forth in Chapter 83 of the Laws of 1973 at least until final hearing, which is presently shheduled for April 29, 1974.
