Dear Mr. Rosenberg:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 26, 1974.

As you are probably aware, an Injunctive Order entered by the Superior Court Chancery Division prohibits this Commission from enforcing the filing deadline for annual reports as required by Chapter 83 of the Laws of 1973. This Injunctive Order will be effective at least through April 29, 1974, which is the date presently set for final hearing.

In addition, in order that we may make a determination with respect to your organization, specifically, I would appreciate it if you would forward to me a brief description of the manner in which you "disseminate information" with respect to bills introduced in the legislature, how often in 1973 you did so and on how many bills you commented. Please feel free to submit any other information to us which will help us to assess the amount of time and effort which your organization has put into the matter of commenting on legislation.

It would also be helpful to know whether your organization takes a position on the bills which have been introduced, whether this position is made known through the dissemination of information and whether or not you urge your members to take a position or action on any of the bills upon which you comment. I take it from your letter that the Association itself engages in no active, direct efforts to influence the legislation regardless of the position taken.
