Therefore, would you please be so kind as to indicate to the Commission the nature of the activities engaged in by the corporation, the purposes for which it was organized, the approximate number of members, and fiscal information with respect to present expenditures, anticipated expenditures and overall budget.

We would also appreciate information with respect to when we might anticipate that the question would be placed on the ballot.
