Dear Mr. Cundari:

This will acknowledge receipt of your request for advisory opinion dated September 2, 1975.

If a contribution of \$200 (or less) were made to two allied candidates by a check payable to both candidates your assumption that the donor's name and address would not have to be disclosed is correct.

Two allied candidates would each be subject to the expenditure limitation of Section 7; that is, each would be allowed to spend the full expenditure limit. Accordingly the combined amount spent in a campaign for both candidates, assuming no specific facts indicated more expenditures on behalf of one candidate, could equal the sum of both expenditure limits.
