> The New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, Chapter 83, Laws of 1973, As Amended and Supplemented ("the Act") Your Letter Dated November 6, 1975 Opinion #(0-30-75)

Dear Mr. Bonanno:

Your letter dated November 6, 1975 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply.

As I understand the facts set forth in your letter, the Municipal Committee did not conduct the campaigns on behalf of the municipal candidates, but those campaigns were conducted by committees for the candidates themselves. The Municipal Committee did, however, conduct and sponsor a brunch eight days prior to the general election. The net balance of the proceeds from that brunch would remain in the Municipal Committee account to finance the general operating costs and will in addition make contributions to the campaign committees for the municipal candidates in order to help them defer "leftover" expenses from that election, and it is proposed that these contributions will be reported if necessary on the annual report made by the Municipal Committee.

Although the facts set forth in your letter indicate there is no connection, it is difficult to imagine a situation in which a brunch conducted eight days prior to an election by the Municipal Committee, to which the candidates of that party for election in that municipality are invited, would not necessarily constitute election activity as to those candidates. This being the case, the Committee must file the pre-election and post-election reports called for by the Act, including information respecting that brunch.
