Dear Mr. Olson:

Your letter dated April 1, 1976 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply.

The Commission does not have authority to advise generally with respect to the election laws, since its authority is limited to the area of its responsibility, which is the New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Disclosure Act (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 and following) ("The Act"). The Act forms only a part of the election law of New Jersey, which is contained in Title 19 of the New Jersey Statutes. The remainder of the election law is under the jurisdiction of the Attorney General of New Jersey.

Section 4 of The Act makes the provisions of The Act applicable, among other things, "in any primary, general, special, school or municipal election for any public office of the state***". There is no exception provided in The Act for election for municipalities governed by commission government as described in Chapter 70 of Title 40 of the statutes of New Jersey. Accordingly, it is the opinion of the Commission that every candidate for an election of the kind described in your letter is obliged to comply with the reporting and other requirements of the Act. The Commission expresses no opinion whether compliance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:73-1 as described in your letter is precluded

by Section 24 of The Act or by other legal principle, and we suggest that you contact the office of the Attorney General for an opinion in this regard.
