Your letter dated June 25, 1976 to the New Jersey  
Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"),  
including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded  
to me for reply.

There are no campaign reports which are required under  
the Act after the date of the final report showing disposition  
with respect to the two items remaining outstanding pertaining  
to the school board campaign as described in your letter of  
June 25th.

The Commission would consider the Eric Tunstall Booster  
Club a political club of a continuing nature similar to a  
political party committee with the obligation of reporting  
on March 1st of each year with respect to its contributions  
and expenditures during the preceding calendar year.
