The New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditure: Reporting Act, Chapter 83, Laws of 1973, as Amended and Supplemented ("the Act")

Your Letter Dated September 3, 1976 Opinion #(0-34-76)

Dear Assemblyman Shapiro:

Your letter dated September 3, 1976 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply.

The Commission does not have authority to advise generally with respect to the election laws, since its authority is limited to the area of its responsibility, which is the New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Disclosure Act (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 and following). This Act forms only a part of the election law of New Jersey, which is contained in Title 19 of the New Jersey Statutes. The remainder of the election law is under the jurisdiction of the Attorney General of New Jersey.

We assume from your letter the funds will not be used for election-related activities, and do not, therefore, subject you to the reporting and other requirements of the Act. are no provisions in the Act with respect to the solicitation of funds or expenditures of funds with respect to the operation of a district office and accordingly the Commission cannot express an opinion with respect to the questions you have raised. We would suggest that you direct your inquiry to the office of the Attorney General.
