Your Letter Dated June 20, 1977 Opinion #(0-29-77)Dear Mr. Villoresi: Your letter dated June 20, 1977 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission, including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply. As I previously discussed with you be telephone, the activities described in your letter in favor of a public question which will appear on the ballot in November would cause the Board of Trustees of the private library to become a political committee with respect to that public question and would require compliance by that committee with the reporting and other requirements of the Act, unless the amount to be expended does not exceed \$100. No opinion is expressed by the Commission with respect to whether the expenditure by such a committee of funds of the committee which had previously been lawfully contributed to the committee out of public monies would or would not be a proper use of such funds.
