The Commission issued an advisory opinion (0-10-77) last year dealing, in part, with the issues raised in your opinion request. A copy of that opinion is enclosed herewith. In response to your specific question, the Commission would regard the use of remaining campaign funds for purchase of tickets to an inaugural affair as a transfer of the funds to the political campaign of another candidate within the meaning of opinion 0-10-77, and, accordingly, would not challenge such transfer.
