Dear Mr. Liston:

Your letter dated February 27, 1978 to the New Jersey
Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"),
including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded
to me for reply.

Nothing in the Act prevents the use of a continuing
political party committee account of the kind described in
your letter. I assume that the procedure which you follow
would simply be to notify the Commission before January 31
of each year of the name of the treasurer and of the desig-
nated depository, and that you will provide the information
with respect to such account on the annual report required
under the statute on March 1 of each year for the preceding
calendar year, and in the pre-election and post-election
reports with respect to any elections as to which you par-
ticipate.

By copy of this letter, I am asking the Commission to
forward to you copy of the Regulations of the Commission
and the forms for reporting under the Act.
