Dear Mr. Johnson:

Your letter dated June 13, 1979 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply.

In the opinion of the Commission, Section 11 of the Act does not prohibit a political club of the kind described in your letter from making contributions to candidates in a primary election.

The Commission is created by Section 5 of the Act and its authority, including the authority to issue legal opinions, is limited by the Act. Authority respecting Title 19 (other than the Act) rests with the Attorney General. For this reason, we are unable to express an opinion with respect to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:34-33. You may wish to seek interpretation of that provision from the office of the Attorney General.
