
Re: The New Jersey Campaign Contributions and

Dear Mr. Ruvoldt:

Your letter dated February 20, 1980 to the New Jersey  
Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"),  
including a request for advisory opinion, has been for-  
warded to me for reply.

Based upon the facts set forth in your letter, the New  
Jersey State Interscholastic Association would have no obli-  
gation of filing pre-election or post-election reports with  
the Commission. To the extent that the organization engages  
in lobbying activity, the group might or might not be required  
to file annual reports with the Commission with respect to  
lobbying activities, depending essentially on whether the level  
of those activities exceeds the prescribed threshold per  
calendar year (\$2,500 under the proposed regulations). In  
this connection, I am asking the Commission to forward to  
you a copy of the proposed regulations of the Commission  
respecting such lobbying activity, which may be of some assistance  
to you.
