The New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, Chapter 83, Laws of 1973 as Amended and Supplemented ("the Act") Your letter dated January 22, 1981 Opinion #0-03-81

Dear Mr. Miller:

Your letter dated January 22, 1981 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply.

It is not clear from the facts set forth in your letter whether there is a filing obligation for your organization.

Under the Act as interpreted by the Supreme Court of New Jersey and the Regulations of the Commission promulgated pursuant thereto, your organization will have an obligation to file the annual report if the total amount expended in direct lobbying (including the costs of the preparation of materials used for direct lobbying) exceeds \$2,500 for the calendar year.

In the event that filing is required, the organization would have the obligation of filing. You as an employee of the organization would not have an independent obligation of filing, whether or not you are compensated.
