Your letter dated March 4, 1981 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply.

The authority of the Commission to give opinion letters is limited to the area of responsibility of the Commission which is Chapter 44A, of Title 19, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1, and following. The remainder of Title 19, including the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:34-38.1 and 38.3, are within the jurisdiction of the Attorney General of New Jersey. Accordingly, the Commission is unable to provide a reply to your request.
