Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Law, P. L. 1975, c.231, annual notice of the meetings of the Commission, as amended, was filed with the Secretary of State's office, copies were posted in the State House Annex, copies were mailed to the Newark Star Ledger and the Philadelphia Bulletin and the entire State House Press Corps.

The meeting convened at 10:15 a.m.

1. E.L.E.C. Schedule of Meetings

The Commission discussed its meeting schedule for the period May through August, 1978 and made the following changes: The meetings previously scheduled for June 7 and July 19 are cancelled and a meeting will be scheduled for July 17. The previously scheduled dates of May 31, June 20 and August 2 were retained.

2. Commission Meeting Minutes

On a motion by Chairman Reiche, seconded by Commissioner Alexander, the Commission voted 3-0 to approve the public session minutes of the Commission meeting of April 12, 1978. Commissioner Margetts abstained because she was absent at that meeting. On a motion by Chairman Reiche, seconded by Vice-Chairman Goldmann, the Commission voted 4-0 to approve the minutes of the Commission meeting of April 19, 1978. Commissioner Alexander voted yes regarding those matters for which he was present at that meeting. On a motion by Chairman Reiche, seconded by Commissioner Alexander, the Commission voted 4-0 to approve the executive session minutes of the Commission meeting of April 19, 1978.

3. Report by Executive Director on E.L.E.C. Budget

The executive director reported on the status of the Commission appropriations for fiscal 1978 and indicated that the appropriations for the Commission for fiscal 1979 as contained in the general appropriations act passed by both houses of the Legislature includes \$40,000 more than the amount recommended by the Governor. He indicated that the Governor has not yet acted on the appropriations bill.

4. Report by Executive Director on Pending Legislation

The executive director reported to the Commission on the current status of bills in the Legislature relating to public financing of gubernatorial primary and general elections, revision of Title 19, lobbyist regulation, State administrative law office, and authorization of public employee payroll deduction for voluntary contributions to political action committees of employee organizations.

5. Additional Commission Presenting Attorney

The Commission approved the addition of Jay Hundertmark, formerly one of the counsels to the State Commission of Investigation, to the Commission's panel of presenting attorneys for use on a case-by-case basis.

6. Current Litigation

Pursuant to C.10:4-12 of the Open Public Meetings Act, the Commission went into executive session on a motion by Chairman Reiche, seconded by Vice-Chairman Goldmann, and a vote of 4-0 to discuss current litigation in New Jersey Chamber of Commerce et al. vs. E.L.E.C. et al. and Socialist Workers Party vs. E.L.E.C.

At the conclusion of the discussion, the Commission remained in executive session to discuss the next item on the agenda.

7. Late Filing Cases from 1976 General Election

After discussion of the cases cited on the attached sheets in executive session, the Commission returned to public session. On a motion by Vice-Chairman Goldmann, seconded by Chairman Reiche, the Commission voted 4-0 to approve the determination of a number of late filing cases for the 1976 general election listed on the attached sheets in accordance with the votes set forth on those sheets.

8. Adjournment - The Commission adjourned the meeting at 1:45 p.m.
