Twenty-day postelection reports show that during the recent campaign for the legislature, Senate and Assembly candidates reported raising \$15,071,611 and spending \$11,268,193, according to Frederick M. Herrmann, Executive Director of the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission.

The figures update those provided in earlier releases which were based on the 29-day and 11-day preelection reports.

"Spending in 1987 was more than double that for the 1983 election," said Herrmann. "Clearly this legislative election was the most expensive in State history."

Prior to 1987, the last time both the State Senate and Assembly were up for election was 1983. In 1983, spending by Senate and Assembly candidates reached \$5.5 million.

The 20-day postelection figures show the Senate candidates raising \$7,232,620 and the Assembly candidates raising \$5,971,427. In terms of expenditures, Senate candidates spent \$5,780,240 and Assembly candidates \$4,973,993.

"Assembly receipts have decreased by 13 percent from the same period in 1985," added Herrmann. "Likewise, Assembly candidates spent 12 percent less than Assembly candidates did two years ago."

Only Assembly comparisons can be made to 1985 because there was no Senate election in that year. In 1985, Assembly candidates raised \$6,827,370 and spent \$5,639,053.

"Democrats raised and spent more money than Republicans did," said Herrmann. "Fundraising by Democrats amounted to \$8,303,329 compared to the Republicans \$6,750,422. Their expenditures equalled \$6,124,765 as opposed to expenditures of \$5,131,945 by Republicans. Independents raised \$17,859 and spent \$11,484.

The 20-day postelection reports reveal that incumbents raised and spent more than challengers did. Incumbents received \$8,985,753 while challengers received \$5,066,171. Incumbents reported spending \$6,667,409 compared to challengers \$4,600,785.

Finally, these reports show that winners were more successful at fundraising than losers were, reporting receipts of \$10,064,387 compared to the losers \$3,926,302. According to Herrmann, winners also spent more money on their campaigns than losers did, \$7,385,585 to \$3,368,649.

A more complete breakdown of financial activity is provided in the attached charts.

The breakdown between Assembly and Senate candidates, between incumbent and challenger candidates, and between Republican and Democratic candidates does not equal the figures for total contributions and expenditures. Some committees supported both Assembly and Senate candidates and it not possible to attribute the funds raised among the Assembly and Senate candidates they supported. Therefore, funds raised and spent by such committees were not counted in the totals. Similarly, it is not possible to divide funds raised and spent by a political committee supporting both challenger and incumbent candidates between those candidates, so such committees were not tabulated in the incumbent/challenger figures. Finally, funds raised by Independent candidates were not counted in the political party figures.
