PRESS RELEASE

According to figures released today by the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC), incumbents have spent over a million dollars more than challengers for the 1991 general election legislative races. Incumbents have spent \$2.9 million and challengers have spent \$1.8 million thus far. Fundraising by incumbents reached almost two million dollars more than challengers. Incumbents raised \$4.5 million to the challengers \$2.5 million. Consequently, incumbents raised 64 percent of the money and spent 61 percent of it. These figures are based upon reports submitted by October 11, 1991, covering activity up to a month before election day.

"These figures are not surprising and follow an upsetting pattern seen in this year's primary election as well as previous legislative races," said Frederick M. Herrmann, Executive Director of the Commission.

"Incumbents clearly have the advantage in getting their messages to the voters when they outraise and outspend their challengers," said Herrmann. "This situation is not good for competitive, democratic government and could be improved by requiring contribution limits," stated Herrmann. ELEC has supported contribution limits upon candidates for some time.

Overall, legislative candidates were not able to raise the amount they raised in 1987, the last time both the Senate and General Assembly were up for election.

Fundraising saw a 4 percent decline from 1987, going from \$7.3 million to \$7 million. Overall spending increased by 29 percent, on the other hand, going from \$3.6 million in 1987 to \$4.7 million in 1991.

"The decline in fundraising is probably the result of the recession," said Herrmann. "Unfortunately, such an economic downturn tends to hurt fundraising efforts by challengers more than incumbents," he said.

Fundraising data for candidates from the two major political parties shows that the Democrats have thus far raised \$3.8 million and the Republicans have raised \$3.1 million. The Independents, meanwhile, were able to raise only \$92,842. Spending figures show that the Democrats have spent more than the Republicans, \$2.7 million to \$2 million. Independents have spent only \$45,499.

The next preelection, candidate reports are due Friday, October 25th.

This press release is a compilation of figures reported to the Commission on statistical information sheets submitted as part of the 29-day preelection report. The data is in rough format and may be subject to change after the reports are more fully reviewed. It should be noted that the Commission has the ability to arrange the data in various other formats upon request.

Only those statistical information sheets submitted by 5:00 p.m. on October 11, 1991, are a part of this release. If a candidate or treasurer failed to submit a statistical information sheet, the staff of ELEC used the report filed by 5:00 p.m. on October 11th to determine financial activity.

Although the Commission has taken all reasonable precautions to prevent mathematical or typographical errors, the possibility that some exist cannot be entirely eliminated. Copies of any report on file with the Commission are available for inspection during regular office hours.

Also, please be reminded that candidates and committees may transfer funds among each other. Although these transfers are counted in ELEC's statistics as receipts and expenditures, they are not transactions which create new funds. Nevertheless, ELEC's figures create a useful indicator of overall fundraising and spending in the 1991 General Election.
