PRESS RELEASE

Frederick M. Herrmann, Executive Director of the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC), announced that at its public meeting today the Commission certified \$811,932 in public matching funds to 1993 gubernatorial primary election candidate Cary Edwards. Herrmann explained that this was the second certification for Candidate Edwards.

Including today's certification, the Commission has certified a total of \$2,930,898.70 in public funds to 1993 gubernatorial primary election candidates as follows:

The Commission will transmit today's certification to the State Treasurer who, it is anticipated, will issue a check later this week. The check will be deposited by the Commission in the candidate's public funds bank account and will be available for use immediately thereafter.

The New Jersey Public Financing Program provides that each dollar of an eligible contribution will be matched with two dollars of public funds after a candidate has raised and expended a minimum of \$177,000 in contributions of \$1,800 or less.
