PRESS ADVISORY

The New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission has proposed new regulations and repeals concerning the reporting requirements of continuing political committees, political party committees and legislative leadership committees. This proposal is another step in implementing the 1993 amendments to the Campaign Reporting Law. Rules governing the establishment of continuing political committees, political party committees and legislative leadership committees were proposed on August 2, 1993 and were adopted on October 18, 1993.
