PRESS ADVISORY

The New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission announced today that it has proposed regulations concerning the reporting of expenditures by candidates, candidate committees, joint candidates committees, political committees, continuing political committees, political party committees, and legislative leadership committees and concerning reporting of independent expenditures. These proposed regulations implement comprehensive statutory amendments made in 1993 to the New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1, et seq. The proposed regulations will appear in the New Jersey Register on June 5, 1995. Copies of the proposal may also be obtained by calling the Commission at (609) 292-8700.

The Commission will conduct a hearing to elicit public comment concerning the proposed regulations. The hearing will be held on Tuesday, June 20, 1995, at 9:15 a.m. at:
