Gubernatorial candidates so far have raised \$28.1 million and spent \$23.3 million for the 2017 primary elections, according to the most recent reports filed with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC).

Reports due 29-days before the election indicate Democratic candidate Phil Murphy has raised (\$19.2 million) and spent (\$18.4 million) the most. Republican candidate Kim Guadagno reported the most cash-on-hand (\$1.5 million).

Along with their direct spending on the primary, independent committees were formed to promote potential gubernatorial candidates before their formal declarations. Some of those groups also were affiliated with prospective candidates that did not run. Those groups spent \$8.2 million in 2016 and earlier years.

Combined this total with direct candidate spending, the governor's race already has cost nearly \$31.5 million. The primary election will be held June 6, 2017.

Jeff Brindle, ELEC's Executive Director, said spending in this year's campaign is running well ahead of the 2013 gubernatorial race.

"At this point four years ago, candidates had expended just \$3.5 million while independent groups had spent about \$9.9 million. That is a total of just \$13.4 million through the 29-day reporting period," Brindle said.

"One big difference is the number of candidates. In 2013, there were just four candidates vying for the two major party nominations. This year, there are 11," he said. Also, two independent groups supporting candidates who opted not to run spent \$1.8 million.

Since the 2001 gubernatorial race, spending by independent groups has become an increasing part of New Jersey campaigns.

Some are formed by or affiliated with prospective candidates before the official start of the primary campaign. The spending is intended to help the candidates become better known within their party and among voters at large.

For instance, before the 2001 campaign, four candidates used non-profit fundraising groups and a federal PAC to spend the equivalent of \$6.9 million (in current dollars) prior to the election.

"I expect other independent groups also will be spending considerable sums on this year's gubernatorial and legislative campaigns. These so-called outside groups spent a record of nearly \$39 million on the 2013 elections," Brindle said.
