The New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) has approved \$1.4 million in public

matching funds for the two major party nominees in this year's 2017 gubernatorial general election.

The disbursement is the first to be received for the general election by Republican nominee Lt. Governor Kimberly Guadagno.

Disbursements of Public Funds to 2017 Gubernatorial General Election Candidates

Under the Gubernatorial Public Financing program, which began in 1974, candidates who raise \$430,000 or more can qualify for public matching funds. General election candidates are eligible for up to \$9.3 million in public funds. In exchange, other than a few exceptions, they must limit their total general election spending to \$13.8 million.
