PRESS ADVISORY

Two freeholder, one county clerk, and fifteen municipal candidates must pay fines and fees totaling approximately \$13,292.31 for violating the Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) announced today.

These enforcement actions, known as final decisions, were approved by the Commission at its April 16, 2019 meeting. In addition, ELEC on April 24, 2019 issued one complaint against a municipal political party committee and organizational treasurers for failure to comply with the Campaign Act. They too, could face fines.
