PRESS ADVISORY

Seven municipal candidates must pay fines and fees totaling \$15,410.88 for violating the Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) announced today.

These enforcement actions, known as final decisions, were approved by the Commission at its September 15, 2020 meeting. In addition, ELEC on September 30, 2020 issued a five-count complaint against two candidates for municipal office and its treasurer for failure to comply with the Campaign Act. They too, could face fines.
