“Open Public Meetings Act,” N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq.

The New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission will have a meeting at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 20, 2020 via GoToWebinar.\*\* The Agenda\* is as follows:

3. **Executive Director’s Report** – The Executive Director will discuss recent staff activities, campaign financing, and other matters of concern and interest to the Commission.
4. **Public Hearing Concerning Proposed New Rules and Amendments to ELEC Regulations to Implement Electronic Filing and Campaign Cost Adjustments** – A public hearing is scheduled for 11:00 at the October 20, 2020 meeting to solicit public comment on proposed new rules and amendments to implement electronic filing and the statutorily-required quadrennial inflationary adjustments to the limits and thresholds in the New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1, et seq. The proposals appeared in the New Jersey Register on July 20, 2020, and are also posted on the Commission’s website.
5. **Public Comments** – The Chairman will ask for public comments at appropriate times during the meeting.
6. **Executive Session.**
