PRESS ADVISORY

Eleven continuing political committees (CPCs) must pay fines and fees totaling \$58,796.00 for violating the Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act (Campaign Act), the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) announced today. These enforcement actions, known as consent orders and final decisions, were approved by the Commission at its December 19, 2023 meeting.
