The New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) has approved \$5,735,095 in public matching funds for two major party candidates in the 2025 gubernatorial primary election. It is the second disbursement from the state's Gubernatorial Public Financing Program.

Combined with an initial disbursement to three other candidates, the total public funds distributed already is \$13,549,021- the most ever for a New Jersey gubernatorial primary election not adjusting for inflation.1

Qualified candidates may file additional submissions for public matching funds through November 5, 2025. March 24, 2025 is the deadline for candidates to qualify for participation in the Gubernatorial Public Financing Program.

Under the program, which began in 1974, candidates who raise \$580,000 or more can qualify for public matching funds. Primary candidates are eligible for up to \$5.5 million in public funds. In exchange, other than a few exceptions, they must limit their total primary spending to \$8.7 million.
