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Business Entity Annual Disclosure Reports Due March 31, 2025

Businesses that received \$50,000 or more in aggregate through public contracts and agreements in calendar year 2024 must file Business Entity Annual Statements (Form BE) with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) by 5 p.m. March 31, 2025¹.

The reports disclose business entity information, cumulative totals for contracts and contributions along with lists of individual contracts and contributions. The annual disclosures are required under N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.27.

In 2024, businesses disclosed \$11.2 million in contributions and \$16.2 billion in contracts for calendar year 2023, according to an analysis done by ELEC.

Business Entity Annual Statements, will be available for public inspection on ELEC's website (www.elec.nj.gov) after 7 p.m. on March 31, 2025. They also can be reviewed at ELEC's offices at 25 S. Stockton Street, 5th floor in Trenton by those without access to the internet.

A public records room is equipped with Internet-ready terminals and a printer. There is no charge for the first 50 pages, thereafter, the fee schedule as provided in the "Open Public Records Act" will apply.

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¹ The statutory due date is March 30 unless the date falls on a weekend or holiday, which is the case this year.
