Unprecedented Primary Fund-raising by NJ Gubernatorial Candidates

Candidates vying for the 2025 gubernatorial primary nominations have raised \$59 million, spent \$43 million and salted away nearly \$16 million in reserves, according to reports filed with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC).

With nearly a month remaining before the June 10, 2025, primary, totals for the current campaign dwarf comparable figures for four previous gubernatorial elections going back to 2009.

A more complete picture of this year's election cost will be possible when several independent spending committees active in the election report their campaign finance activity on May 30, 2025.

Breaking down totals by party, six Democrats seeking their party nomination have raised \$40.7 million, spent \$30 million and have \$10.5 million in the bank.

Four Republicans in the race reported raising \$18.3 million, spending \$12.9 million and setting aside \$5.4 million for the final stretch. One Republican candidate has yet to file a disclosure report with ELEC.
